

TECHNICAL CERTIFICATION FORM FOR PENNVEST LOANS/ ON-LOT MALFUNCTION REPAIRS/ REPLACEMENT

This form includes several statements which must be confirmed by your municipal officials or your system designer to determine eligibility for a PENNVEST loan to repair your on-lot sewage disposal system. Once you have the required signatures and the other documents described in the "Technical Approval Process" take these documents along with other required technical documents to a local lending institution which participates in the PENNVEST Homeowner Septic Loan Program. Please make sure all of the information is completed and any required signatures are obtained.

PART II. MUNICIPAL SIGN OFF

A municipal official such as a township supervisor or borough council member must sign off in this section.

PART III. DESIGNER SIGN OFF

The individual who designed your repair system must sign off in this section:

(The designer must be an SEO or PE if the system is an experimental or alternate on-lot or single residence sewage treatment plant.)

DO NOT BEGIN CONSTRUCTION OF THE REPAIR SYSTEM UNTIL YOU RECEIVE WRITTEN LOAN APPROVAL FROM THE LENDING INSTITUTION. IF CONSTRUCTION BEGINS BEFORE LOAN APPROVAL YOU WILL BECOME INELIGIBLE FOR A LOAN.
