## **Indication to Participate**

Pennsylvania Housing Finance Agency (PHFA) is pleased to announce that HUD has awarded a third round of 811 subsidy. As the Grantee, PHFA continues to partner with PA Department of Human Services (DHS) to refer 811 eligible applicants to participating properties. The 811 PRA program is seeking the participation of properties to set aside units for the program through the Agency's Low Income Housing Tax Credit Application process. Eligible, participating owner/agents can receive points in the FY 25 LIHTC Application round.

To be eligible for this program, any rental property must meet these criteria:

- It must be a new or existing low-income housing tax credit property with financing under the federal Home Investment Partnership Act (HOME) or **other** federal funding program.
- It must contain at least **five housing units**.
- It must be for general occupancy or 55-plus populations; eligible participants in the program must be **age 18–61** at move in.
- Units must meet program criteria for unit integration and accessibility and be accessible to transportation and services.
- No more than **25 percent** of the units at a participating property:
  - May receive 811 project rental assistance payments
  - May be used for supportive housing for people with disabilities, or
  - May have an occupancy preference for people with disabilities.

One-bedroom units will be a priority in projects that are located in areas with community amenities, including transportation, social services, health care and retail services as determined in the QAP.
