



2018 Home4Good Frequently Asked Questions

PHFA has received the following questions regarding the RFP for the 2018 Home4Good program. We hope this guidance will assist you and your organization through the application process.

Q: Our regional Continuum of Care will not be participating in the Home4Good program. Will this hinder our application?

A: No, this will not affect your proposal in any way. Proposals from service providers located within the service area of a CoC that has elected not to participate will reviewed by the Home4Good review committee and ranked along with all any additional applications received from within that service area.

Q: The RFP states that proposals must address one of the Home4Good Program Goals. Is it acceptable to list more than one goal if we believe we can meet more than one?

A: Yes, we welcome programs that will make the greatest community impact. Please feel free to address more than one program goal.

Q: As the participating CoC, we intend to submit a proposal on our own behalf. Can we apply on behalf of the service providers within our service area and contract directly with them?

A: Yes and No. Participating Continuums of Care are welcome to apply for Home4Good funds on their own behalf, but that proposal must be its own individual application. All proposals submitted to the CoC from other service providers must be reviewed, ranked, and submitted to PHFA for funding consideration.
