

2018 PHFA Multifamily Affordable Housing Conference

Request for Presentations

The Pennsylvania Housing Finance Agency (PHFA) invites interested speakers to submit a Proposal to Present at the Multifamily Affordable Housing Conference. The purpose of the conference is to provide quality learning and networking opportunities to resident service coordinators, service providers, property and on-site managers, and others who are involved in affordable rental housing. Attendees should gain new knowledge and experience and the ability to design and carry out service programs that enrich residents' lives, build strong communities, and improve the financial position of the property.

Audience

Each year, approximately 500-600 people attend PHFA's MAH Conference and each breakout session attracts between 30 and 120 people. Participants include resident service coordinators, supportive services providers, on-site and regional property managers, state and local government representatives, staff from public housing and redevelopment authorities, and representatives from various social service agencies.

Conference participants come from Pennsylvania and surrounding states. Attendees work with senior citizens, families, and residents with special needs (persons with disabilities, victims of domestic violence, persons who were formerly homeless, etc.)

Presentation Format

Presenters should plan for a 60 or 120 minute presentation to educate and inform attendees of new or innovative topics/trends or to provide in-depth training and instruction on more familiar topics. Each session should be identified as basic, intermediate, or advanced. PHFA will provide a moderator and room monitor for each session.
