Subject: Pennsylvania Housing Tax Credit – FY 2025-2026 Annual Report

Enclosed for your review is the Annual Report for the Pennsylvania Housing Tax Credit as required by Act 25 of 2021. The attached report reflects the status of credits awarded under the below outlined process, as of October 1, 2025. Act 45 of 2025 changes the process going forward, therefore next year's report will reflect the status of credits awarded under both processes.

Background:

Initially established pursuant to amendments to the Tax Reform Code of 1971 via Act 107 of 2020, and subsequently funded under Act 25 of 2021, Article XIX-G establishes the Pennsylvania Housing Tax Credit to be administered by the Pennsylvania Housing Finance Agency (PHFA). PHFA is authorized to allocate \$10 million annually in state credits to assist with financing the construction or preservation of affordable housing meeting the requirements of the Federal Low-Income Housing Tax Credit (federal housing tax credit) and in conformance with the Agency's Qualified Allocation Plan (QAP). PHFA is further permitted to carry forward any unused tax credits to be allocated in a future funding cycle.

State credits are initially "conditionally reserved" for successful applicants and upon completion of the development and confirmation of program compliance, receive credit certificates after which the investor is able to begin claiming the credit.

To date the Agency has conditionally reserved state credits under two funding cycles and the attached list contains the development name, developers, amount of conditionally reserved state credits and the state credit investors for projects that met all Agency requirements to move to the construction phase.

Note that while the Act 25 of 2021 included language requiring the Agency to report on tax credits awarded, which does not formally occur until issuance of the tax credit certificates, we are providing the attached information to demonstrate the progress that has occurred with this program. Future reports will include expanded information relating to the final credit amounts awarded as developments complete construction and meet the compliance requirements for receipt of credit certificates.
